



Jonquil Vineyards

Pope Valley, California

NORD VINEYARDS

The shallow, non-serpentine soils at this Pope Valley site in the Napa Valley's northeast corner promote big, full-bodied, luscious wines. Jonquil ("daffodil") also showcases the Nord family's commitment to preservation and sustainability as the vineyards sit among wildflowers, huge gnarled oak trees, and native American cultural sites.

SITE CHARACTERISTICS

- ❏ A complex landscape of hills and creeks, with blocks carefully matched to topography
- ❏ Soils are Pleasonton loam with areas of Bressa-Dibble complex
- ❏ Climate is similar to Calistoga, with warm, sunny summer days
- ❏ Ample water supply allows frost protection and careful irrigation when needed



SUSTAINABILITY

- ❏ Streambank erosion sites restored with natural structures: willow revetments and rock bars
- ❏ A wetland was created providing wildlife habitat
- ❏ No-till floors of clovers and annual grasses protect the soil from erosion
- ❏ Plow-down cover crops add organic matter and a source of nitrogen

PLANTINGS

- ❏ Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Sauvignon Blanc, Merlot
- ❏ Cabernet clones include 337, 191, 24, 2, 4, and 8
- ❏ Rootstocks include 101-14, 110R, 3309, and 1103P
- ❏ Trellising: VSP and split canopy
- ❏ Plantings made in 2001
- ❏ Row orientations are northeast-southwest, with good protection of the fruit zone
